Online Registration

Hockey Canada is using Spordle for Registration this year.

- FIRST STEP: Every family will need a <u>Spordle My Account</u> in the parents name.
- Within your account you can then add/link all your related members in the Link a Member. Search players and coaches by name
 and date of birth to locate and select.
- If the member is not there, you can create a new member. If they are there but Confed Hockey is not available, please email
 <u>Registrar@confedhockey.org</u> to make arrangements to transfer the member.
- Once participants have been added to the account you will be able to register for your desired club directly through the Spordle Dashboard.

New Players:

All new players, please submit new player documents. They can be emailed or uploaded in the documents section of the members Spordle account:

- Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport
- Copy of Proof of Residency by way of a recent utility (gas, water, power) bill in the parents name showing the service address and date and/or Drivers Licence.

Transferring Players:

Players that are coming to Confed Hockey from another club, please email <u>registrar@confedhockey.org</u> so we can confirm that you are within in the <u>catchment</u> and welcome you to the club.

All transferring players, please submit:

- Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport (can be emailed or uploaded during registration)
- <u>Hockey Alberta Parent Declaration Form</u> with Proof of Residency recent utility (gas, water, power) bill in the parents name showing the service address and date and/or Drivers Licence.

Once Parent Declaration is received the transfer will be requested electronically from your previous club, once approved you will be able to register with Confed Hockey.

Payment Options:

Payments can be made by credit card or e-transfer.

Confederation Hockey Streams of Play

Confederation Hockey Club is excited to continue the delivery our innovative Confederation Hockey Streams of Play model. The <u>Confederation Hockey Streams of Play package</u> provides information about the program.

A Streams of Play model gives families the opportunity to participate in a hockey program that best suits their needs. Our Streams of Play model adds more transparency to the cost and time commitment for playing hockey.

Selection of Program

<u>U7:</u>

- Registration for the U7 programs, Discovery (2019), JR Timbits (2018), and SR Timbits (2017) is dependent on birth year.
- A player born in 2019 can only play in Discovery.
- A player born in 2018 is designated to JR Timbits, but could chose Discovery if they wish. If wanted to move up to SR Timbits, players will have to participate in timed evaluation in September and place in the top 25% of the age group higher (SR Timbits).
- A player born in 2017 is designated to SR Timbits, but could chose JR Timbits if they wish.

U9, U11, and U13:

- All programs have designated birth years U9 (2015, 2016), U11 (2013, 2014), U13 (2011, 2012)
- During online registration all players will reminded of the <u>Confederation Hockey Streams of Play</u>, with a suggestion to review the programs prior to answering questions regarding their Stream preference.
- During team formation, every effort will be made to place players on a team within their chosen program, while also placing them in an appropriate tier.
- The preferred Stream of Play selection is not guaranteed and placing the players in the correct tier is the first priority.

Rec League The Recreational Hockey League (Rec League) will be run by Hockey Edmonton this year. If you are only looking for one game a week and no practices, please reach out to office@hockeyedmonton.ca	U13 AA If your child will be trying out for U13 AA please also register for Confed Hockey. If your player is placed on a U13 AA team, in one of the 4 sanctioned athletic clubs, you will be refunded in full by Confed Hockey.

Player Evaluations

U7 Discovery does not have an evaluation.

U7 JR Timbits does not have an evaluation. In the event you would like to challenge to move from JR Timbits to SR Timbits, you will need to attend the preseason skate.

U7 SR Timbits has a preseason skate to run through our evaluation drills and equipment.

At U9, U11, and U13 the purpose of Evaluations is to place the children on teams with similar ability level players that will play against similar tiered teams in the Hockey Edmonton/EFHL programs.

Confederation Hockey is a volunteer run organization that depends on the volunteer assistance of its members to function successfully. Volunteers are essential to maintaining and growing Confederation Hockey Club. The more volunteers we have, the better our association becomes!

- Every family is required to complete volunteer commitments for 2023-24 unless they have chosen to pay the volunteer opt out fee on their registration.
- The number of volunteer commitments for each family is dependent on the number of players and which category they are in.
- We would rather have families complete volunteer commitments and contribute to the success of the club than pay the opt out fee.
- U7 Discovery, JR Timbits, and SR Timbits players are required to complete ONE VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT per player
- U9, U11, and U13 payer families are required to complete TWO VOLUNTEER COMMITMENTS per player.
- Volunteer deposit cheques or credit card payments are \$250 per commitment and are collected prior the registration being accepted and completed.
- In the event that a family does not complete their volunteer commitments, the volunteer deposit cheque will be cashed or card charged the balance of payment. If you do not have cheques, you can use credit card for \$5 charge.
