Installment Dates

- payment options increased to 3 or 4 payments available to assist families with fees

Online Registration - Using Hockey Canada Spordle

- •Every family will need a <u>Spordle My Account</u> in the parents name.
- •Within your account you can then add/link all your related members in the Link a Member. Search players and coaches by name and date of birth to locate and select.
- •If the member is not there, you can create a new member. If they are there but Confed Hockey is not available, please email Registrar@confedhockey.org to make arrangements to transfer the member.
- •Once participants have been added to the account you will be able to register for your desired club directly through the Spordle Dashboard.

New Players:

All new players, please submit new player documents. They can be emailed or uploaded in the documents section of the members Spordle account:

Transferring Players:

Players that are coming to Confed Hockey from another club, please email registrar@confedhockey.org so we can confirm that you are within in the catchment and welcome you to the club.

All transferring players, please submit:

- •Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport (can be emailed or uploaded during registration)
- •<u>Hockey Alberta Parent Declaration Form</u> with Proof of Residency Parent Drivers Licence or recent utility (gas, water, power) bill in the parents name showing the service address and date

Once the Parent Declaration is received the transfer will be requested electronically from your previous club, once approved you will be able to register with Confed Hockey.
